

Day 5 – Thursday, May 21 – Strength for the Harvest

Scripture: Colossians 1:9-11

Focus of Prayer: Divine endurance and physical/spiritual strength to finish the work.

Prayer Points:

1. Thank God because He gives power to the faint and increases strength to those with no might.
2. Pray that God will "strengthen you with all might" according to His glorious power.
3. Ask God for the grace to remain consistent and "unmovable" in your walk with Him.
4. Pray against weariness, burnout, or discouragement for every worker in AHOWFC.
5. Ask the Lord of the Harvest to send more laborers and to keep the current laborers energized and focused.

Day 6 – Friday, May 22 – Unity in the Body

Scripture: Acts 2:42-47

Focus of Prayer: Walking in "one accord" to create an atmosphere for the miraculous.

Prayer Points:

1. Thank God for the unity and love that already exists within the AHOWFC family.
2. Pray that the Holy Spirit will knit our hearts together in love, and dissolve any roots of bitterness, anger or division among us.
3. Ask God for a greater level of "corporate anointing" will fall anytime we gather together in one place as a church in every campus.

4. Pray that the same grace upon the early church we rest upon us and we would be of one heart and soul, sharing our lives and resources with one another freely.
5. Ask God to make AHOWFC a model of Christ-like unity that the world may believe.

Day 7 – Saturday, May 23 – Anointed for Impact

Scripture: Isaiah 61:1-3

Focus of Prayer: A final push for the heavy-duty anointing to impact our generation.

Prayer Points:

1. Thank God for the 7-day journey and for the breakthroughs already won in the spirit through this time of prayer.
2. Cry out for a double portion of the Spirit's power to do "greater works" in AHOWFC than those we have seen before.
3. Pray that as we enter Pentecost Sunday, the fire of God will fall tangibly on every person in the sanctuary in every campus.
4. Declare that you are going forth to preach good tidings, bind up the broken-hearted, and proclaim liberty.
5. Pray that the impact of this fast will result in permanent transformation and a lasting move of God in our cities.
6. Pray for the service tomorrow and for Bishop Mattera, that God will anoint him and use him to ignite His fire in us and among us.

Day 1 – Sunday, May 17 – Consecration for Service

Scripture: Romans 12:1-2

Focus of Prayer: Preparing our hearts and bodies as vessels worthy of the Master's use.

Prayer Points:

1. Thank God for the privilege of being called into His service and for the gift of His grace upon your life.
2. Pray for a spirit of repentance, asking God to cleanse every area of your life from sin, distractions and anything that will prevent you from being a worthy vessel for him.

3. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you yield your will, talents, and resources entirely to Him.
4. Pray that every member of AHOWFC will live a life of holiness that attracts the presence of God.
5. Pray that you will be a vessel of honor, sanctified and ready for the "greater works" ahead.

Day 2 – Monday, May 18 – The Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation

Scripture: Ephesians 1:17-19

Focus of Prayer: Gaining spiritual insight to understand our divine assignment .

Prayer Points:

1. Thank God for the Spirit of Truth who leads and guides us into all reality.
2. Pray for the "eyes of your understanding" to be enlightened to see the opportunities for greater works around you.
3. Ask God for divine wisdom to handle complex situations in your life, family workplace, and ministry.
4. Pray that AHOWFC leadership will continue to receive clear revelation and direction for this new season.
5. Pray against spiritual blindness, asking God to reveal the "hope of His calling" in every AHOWFC member's life.

Day 3 – Tuesday, May 19 – Boldness to Witness

Scripture: Acts 4:29-31

Focus of Prayer: Receiving the courage to share the Gospel and manifest God's power.

Prayer Points:

1. Thank God for the power of the Gospel which is the power of God unto salvation.
2. Ask the God for "great boldness" to speak His word without fear of man or persecution.
3. Pray that God will stretch out His hand to heal and perform signs and wonders through our hands.
4. Pray for a greater burden for lost souls around us and in our community and that we would be effective witnesses.
5. Ask God to remove every spirit of timidity and replace it with the spirit of power, love, and a sound mind..

Day 4 – Wednesday, May 20– Spiritual Gifts and Manifestations

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 12:7-11

Focus of Prayer: The activation of the gifts of the Spirit for the profit of all.

Prayer Points:

1. Thank God for the diversity of gifts He has placed within the Body of Christ at AHOWFC.
2. Pray for the activation of the gifts of the Spirit (prophecy, healing, miracles, etc.) in your life.
3. Ask God to help you identify and stir up the specific spiritual gifts He has deposited in you.
4. Pray that our services will be characterized by the authentic and orderly manifestation of God's Spirit and power.
5. Decree that no gift shall be dormant in AHOWFC and that we will serve one another in love.
