Day 1 – Thursday, July 18, 6:00pm – 6:45pm – Preparation of Hearts – Ade Adedeji

1. Blessed Father, thank you for establishing AHOWFC annual retreat as a time for blessing, rejuvenation and divine encounter for our entire congregations.

Day 2 – Friday, July 19, 6:00pm – 6:45pm – Inviting the Holy Spirit - Genevieve Kumapley

1. Holy Spirit, I ask that you will usher in your presence and expressly manifest yourself in our midst. We invite you and give you the permission to do as you will among us.
2. Lord breathe upon our prayer marathon and supercharge us to experience the Holy Spirit like never before. Give everyone grace to intercede like never before so we may experience you like never before. James 5:16

Day 3 – Saturday, July 20, 5:00pm – 6:00pm – Blessed Life Prayer Marathon Finale – Jide Lawore

1. Praise God for the blessings we have received in Christ by grace and thank God for the theme “The Blessed Life” and for our prayer marathon – Ephesians 1:3-5
2. Prayer for true understanding of the believer’s attitudes – Matthew 5: 3-12.
 - a. A blessed life is more than what we do; it is who we are.
 - b. Ask God to let you experience every blessing Christ mentioned in that famous Sermon on the Mount.
3. Pray that you will live for God’s glory and not for the praise and honor that come from human beings – Matthew 5:11-12.
4. Pray that God will give everyone an unforgettable encounter at the retreat and a deeper hunger and thirst for righteousness – Matthew 5:6.
5. Pray that you will know God more than ever before; that Jesus the Son of God will be revealed to you and in AHOW – Matthew 16:16-18.
6. Pray that in our lives and families we will put God first; that Jesus will have preeminence and every distraction will be frustrated – Psalm 128:1-6; Colossians 1:18.
7. Pray that we will uphold the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace; that God will deal with unforgiveness, strife, envy, and things that foster division among us His people – Psalm 133:1-3; Ephesians 4:3-4.
8. Pray that in AHOW, we will walk in “the most excellent way”; the way of love toward one another – I Corinthians 13:1-13.
