## OVERVIEW

Access to good sanitary pads is a necessity for any girl who has reached the age of puberty. This necessity however is not affordable for many girls in some parts of the world. This is particularly a challenge in the continents of Africa and Asia. Our mission is to make this monthly experience a little easier for underprivileged young teenage girls, especially orphans living in the continent of Africa; by providing sanitary pads to use during their monthly menstrual cycle. The goal of the Give A Pad (GAP) Project is to provide an annual supply of sanitary pads to at least 1000 orphan teen girls every year.

## OUR VISION

The goal of the GAP initiative is to provide sanitary pads and supplies to teenage girls who live in orphanages in Africa.

## OUR MISSION

### PROVIDE

- Provide a one-year supply of sanitary pads
- Provide panties and bras.
- Provide each girl with a GAP Girls Gear Box (Panties & Bra & Educational Book)

### INSPIRE

- Empower the girls to embrace their uniqueness as emerging young women
- Nurture and support the emotional and physical well-being of the girls

### EDUCATE

- Educate the girls about their menstrual hygiene
- Teach general education about puberty and abstinence
