Pastor Jide Lawore

Pastor Jide Lawore is the founder and the Apostolic Leader of the Agape House of Worship Family of Churches, an apostolic church with global influence with headquarter in Roselle, NJ. Pastor Jide (PJ as he is fondly called) is an astute teacher of the Word, a visionary leader, and a passionate kingdom builder. He is passionate about equipping God's people to achieve their God-given destiny and raising Spirit-filled leaders for Christ through training and impartation. Pastor Jide travels worldwide, strengthening, and empowering pastors and church leaders by preaching the gospel of the kingdom with power, authority, and signs and wonders.

Pastor Jide did not originally set out to be a pastor, he obtained a bachelor's and a master's degree in engineering and was having a successful career as Project Management Professional (PMP) before the Lord called him into a full-time ministry. He has authored two widely acclaimed books: GPS-God's Positioning System: Locating God's Plan for Your Life and Extreme Makeover: The Secret of Genuine Transformation. He is happily married to his lovely wife, Bimbola Lawore, a co-laborer in the ministry. Together they are blessed with three wonderful children, Joel, Ebun, and Ife.



BISHOP REFORD MOTT, MPS; M.DIV; D.MIN

Bishop Mott is the Founder and Lead Pastor of Generations Church in lower Westchester County, NY. He and his wife, Sherrie are the proud parents of five children and sixteen grandchildren. Together, they responded to God's call to plant their church in September of 1994, which began as a home Bible study and quickly grew into what is now a multi-cultural non-denominational church with locations in Mount Vernon NY, New Rochelle NY, and Tamil Nadu City in Chennai India.

Not long after establishing the church, he began to build relationships with local pastors and quickly discovered his passion to serve those involved in church leadership. In 2007, he formed the Remnant Pastors and Leaders Network, whose vision and purpose was to help foster authentic friendships and build accountability among pastors within the region. His leadership and influence has reached well beyond his region to impact leaders in other states and nations of the world. Because of his love for and dedication to serving the churches and its leaders, Bishop Mott was consecrated to the bishopric in August of 2012 by the Right Reverend H. Curtis Douglas of Dabar Bethlehem Cathedral, who recognized and affirmed his calling as a Bishop.

Bishop Mott's love for education led him to Alliance Theological Seminary, where he earned his Master of Professional Service (MPS) degree in Urban Ministry. Thereafter, he continued his studies at Gordon Conwell Seminary in Massachusetts where he earned his Master of Divinity (M.Div.) and eventually went on to earn his Doctor of Ministry in Urban Leadership in May 2016.

As a response to the Ferguson riots in 2014, he partnered with local clergy and law enforcement to form the Clergy Rapid Response Team to work with the local police in times of crisis in helping to preserve the peace in the City of New Rochelle. The rapid response team continues to serve its community and has been instrumental in helping to stave off several riots since.

Bishop Mott also serves as Vice President of Christ Covenant Coalition (CCC), a global network of pastors and business leaders, whose purpose is to do life together while expanding the Kingdom of God into new territories. CCC is a family on mission that also provides pastoral oversight, theological education, and cutting-edge leadership development tools for pastors across North America.

Generations Church is a sending church, and has planted churches in the Middle East, as well as partnered with Christ Covenant Coalition to establish the Lebanon Project aimed at assisting the proliferation of the gospel through Christian education in Lebanon.

Additionally, Bishop Mott provides pastoral oversight to several churches locally and abroad and considers himself a 'spiritual father' to many leaders around the world.

Bishop Mott counts it a privilege to be called by God and takes joy in serving his congregation and his city. He believes that the church is a global force for good that will only grow stronger as evil increases.
